2007 Jamey Thiel Miller Memorial **Legislative Award**

An award for a SNAP member or SNAP chapter.

Jamey Lynn Thiel Miller (November 8, 1968 – August 15, 2001) was a 1991 graduate of Villanova University College of Nursing. She served as chapter president, as well as two terms as SNAP's Legislative Coordinator. Jamey explored a strong interest in government and public health issues related to nursing. Jamey died after a long battle against glioblastoma – a type of brain cancer. This award is dedicated to her memory in remembrance of all she gave to SNAP and the nursing profession.

Deadline: Postmarked by October 15, 2007

Judging

The purpose of this award is to encourage, acknowledge and pay tribute to a SNAP **member or chapter** for their political awareness and participation in activities related to the political process. Activities include but are not limited to: participation in legislative internships, volunteering for political campaigns, attending Capitol Hill Day, conducting voter registration drives, activity in "Young Republicans" or "Young Democrats," student presentations, etc.

Criteria

Applicant must be a member of SNAP/NSNA on October 1st of the year the award is given. The applicant must submit proof of membership (copy of NSNA membership card or cancelled check) along with the application.
