Dr. Dowdell has made significant and sustained contributions as a nursing leader and advocate for vulnerable children. She has contributed more than any other nurse scientist to the knowledge on perilous internet behaviors of youth. Her research as explored the interrelationships among various forms of electronic aggression, including "cyber-bullying" and "sexting".

The use of social media across the globe is expanding exponentially as the number of social media outlets, applications, and access continue to increase. Along with this growth in connectivity come concerns about child Internet victimization as well as new phenomena associated with technology. She can address how risky online behaviors endanger vulnerable children, how technology affects a child's and family's everyday life and the emergence of new technology-related behaviors like sleep texting.

Her extensive research certainly demonstrates the convention theme "Nurses: Advocates in Action!" Please join us in welcoming Dr. Dowdell to the SNAP Convention this November.
