From Harrisburg area: Take I-83 North to I-81 North. Continue on I-81 to I-80 East to I-380 North. At the first exit (Pocono Exit 3) turn East on Route 940 to I-314 East. Turn right into Kalahari Resorts on Kalahari Boulevard.

From Lehigh Valley area: Take Route 22 to PA Turnpike (I-476). Continue North on Turnpike to Pocono Exit 95 to I-80 East to I-380 North. At first exit (Pocono Exit 3), turn East on Route 940 to I-314 East. Turn right into Kalahari Resorts on Kalahari Boulevard.
