# What is a pre-slate?

A pre-slate is a candidate that submits a Consent to Serve to run for office before October 25, 2023. A pre-slate of candidates running for SNAP positions will be selected and announced by the Nominations and Elections Committee.

SNAP members can also run from the floor at convention if nominated by a peer.

# What is the process of running for a position like?

A professional headshot and Consent to Serve form are required to run for SNAP office.

In campaigning at convention, candidates are allowed to bring a poster. Each candidate will be asked to have a speech prepared of 2 minutes maximum, and the presidential candidates of 5 minutes maximum.
