Redesigning Nursing's Future NOW!

SNAP is very pleased to have Dr. Boston-Leary serve as our Keynote Speaker for our 71st SNAP Convention! Dr. Boston-Leary is the Director of Nursing Programs at the American Nurses Association (ANA), overseeing the Nursing Practice and Work Environment Division and Healthy Nurse Healthy Nation. She is also the Co-Lead for Project Firstline, a multi-million dollar grant collaborative with the CDC for training on Infection Prevention and Control. Katie is also the co-chair for the DEI committee for the Healthcare Leaders Network Delaware Valley, an ACHE affiliate.

She helped redesign the Nurse Leadership Institute at the University of Maryland with an embedded coaching program. Dr. Boston-Leary serves as staff on the National Commission to Address Racism in Nursing and is also part of the National Academy of Science and Medicine's National Plan to Address Clinician Well-Being supported by the U. S. Surgeon General, Dr. Vivek Murthy. She is a well-known speaker nationally and internationally with many publications and podcast invitations. She has written and co-authored numerous articles on staffing, diversity and leadership and was recently featured on NBC's Today Show to discuss the nurse staffing crisis that is impacting health care delivery.

Directions To Kalahari Resorts

From Philadelphia area: Take I-95 North to the Northeast Extension of the PA Turnpike (I-476). Proceed North on Turnpike to Pocono Exit 95 to I-80 East to I-380 North. At first exit (Pocono Exit 3), turn East on Route 940 to I-314 East. Turn right into Kalahari Resorts on Kalahari Boulevard.

From Points West: Take the PA Turnpike (I-76) east towards Harrisburg. Take Harrisburg East exit (247) and continue North on I-283 to I-83 North to I-81 North. Continue on I-81 to I-80 East to I-380 North. At the first exit (Pocono Exit 3) turn East on Route 940 to I-314 East. Turn right into Kalahari Resorts on Kalahari Boulevard.

From Harrisburg area: Take I-83 North to I-81 North. Continue on I-81 to I-80 East to I-380 North. At the first exit (Pocono Exit 3) turn East on Route 940 to I-314 East. Turn right into Kalahari Resorts on Kalahari Boulevard.

From Lehigh Valley area: Take Route 22 to PA Turnpike (I-476). Continue North on Turnpike to Pocono Exit 95 to I-80 East to I-380 North. At first exit (Pocono Exit 3), turn East on Route 940 to I-314 East. Turn right into Kalahari Resorts on Kalahari Boulevard.
