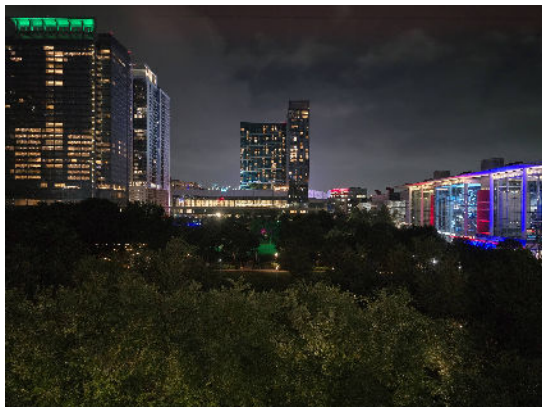
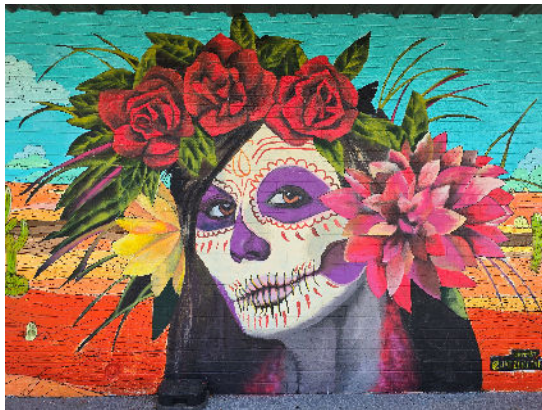


NSNA 2026 Convention

Graduation Pins and Cords are Available

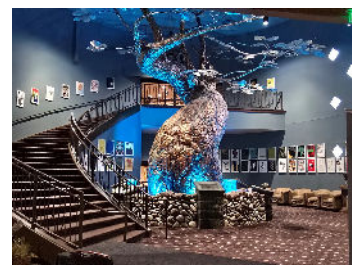
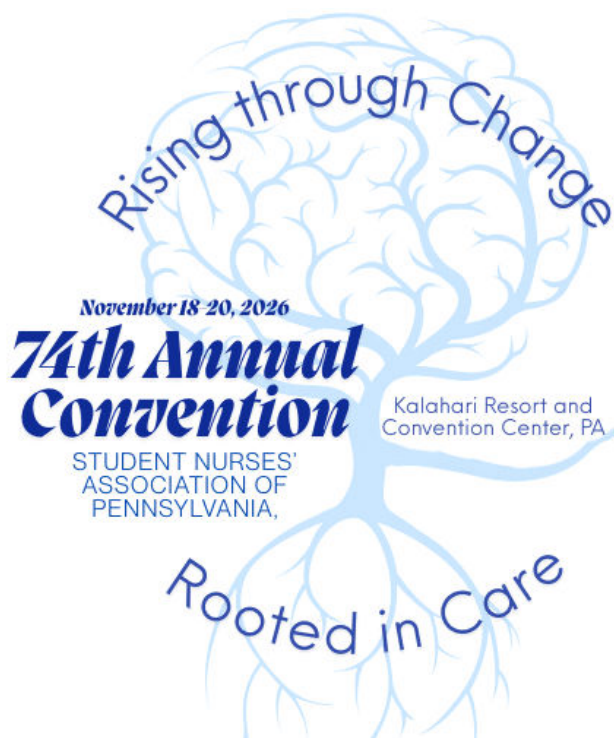
